Administrative Approval is hereby accorded to the Up-gradation/Improvement and resurfacing of Mughal Road (Length of 84 km 110 meters) at an estimated cost of Rs 47.41 Crore only for "Providing/laying of renewal coat by way of providing/laying 100 mm WMM (in patches/stretchers), 75/50mm thick BM (in patches/stretchers), 25mm semi-dense including 6mm thick seal coat & protection measures by way of laying of crates" as per the cost abstract given at **Annexure** to this Government Order.

The Administrative Approval is subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. *The works shall be executed after observing all Codal /procedural formalities.*
2. *The detailed estimate of works shall be technically sanctioned by the competent authority.*
3. *It must be ensured that there shall be no multisource of funding or overlapping of schemes under different programmes.*
4. *The work shall be implemented and completed within the stipulated time frame and definitely by 2021-22.*
5. *The proposal is strictly devised and designated as per the relevant Code of BIS/CPWD/MoRTH/IRC specification.*
6. *The items related to the quantity of earthworks shall conform to the authenticated NSLs, design cross sections and L-Sections. Moreover, renovation shall be based on proper design and other parameters duly approved by competent authority.*
7. *The projects are designed as per latest relevant I.S. Codes and specifications of MoRTH/PWD/CPWD and same is authenticated and proof checked by the competent authority. While designing, latest HFL has to be taken into consideration.*
8. *Standard specifications/Quality control shall be maintained in accordance with standards set under MoRTH/ CPWD/IRC Code and I.S. Standards.*
9. *High emphasis is placed on proper geometrics and gradient of the road with installation of informatory/sign boards reference pillars etc and adequate provision made for road safety measures.*
10. *Any such item(s) not covered under relevant schedule of rates shall be paid in accordance with the set Codal Procedure. That there is no time or cost overrun involved in the project and set time line is strictly adhered to.*
11. *E-tendering mode and proper Codal procedure as mandatory for finalization of award of contract is followed and working DPR adopted in the advertised BOQ. Fragmentation of project while tendering to be avoided.*

12. Proper rate analysis and market survey is conducted in light of standing rules and procedures in case of all the items proposed to be executed on ground prior to issuance of formal NIT, in order to ensure rationality of rates.

13. The expenditure on this account shall be debit able to relevant account head.
