Whereas, you allowed the said contractor to keep excavating and building the road causing more and more damage while you could have stopped him well in time and the damage to the forest trees and land would not have been caused.

Whereas, by acting in the aforesaid manner, you have failed to maintain absolute integrity in the discharge of your official duties, which is unbecoming of a public servant and as such you are liable for departmental action as envisaged in Rule. 33/34 of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Conduct and Appeal) Rules, 1956.
