AND WHEREAS, the matter has been examined/considered with reference to the rules governing the subject and it has been observed that the concerned officials were still on probation and have not qualified the prescribed probation period of service;

AND WHEREAS, Rule 21(1) of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal), Rules, 1956, governs regulation of probation in the Government service and provides as under:-

"At any time before the expiry of prescribed period of probation the appointing authority may:

- a. suspend the probation of a probationer and discharge him from the service for want of vacancy; and*
- b. at its discretion terminate the probation of a probationer and discharge him from the service."*

NOW THEREFORE, in terms of Rule 21(1) (b) of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956, the probation of the following Junior Engineers (Civil) is hereby terminated and they are discharged from Government Service with effect from the dates as indicated against each, on their own request:
