Subject:- Regularization of Engineers (Mechanical)-Submission of APRs and other requisite documents.

**NOTICE**


The Department is in the process of submitting a proposal to the Establishment-Cum-Selection Committee (ECSC) for considering the regularization of Engineers to the post of Chief Engineers (Mechanical). However, during examination, it has been found that many engineers have not submitted complete APRs for the relevant period, Work & Conduct/Integrity Certificates and posting details since entry into service for uploading on the VC portal to determine their vigilance status. Without these documents, the proposal for their regularization as Chief Engineer (Mechanical) cannot be taken to the Establishment-Cum-Selection Committee.

This Department has repeatedly informed all engineers to upload their APRs and other requisite documents on the Department's portal, JKPWDOMS, and posting details on the VC portal. Despite this, many engineers have not adhered to these instructions.

Therefore, the following Engineers (retired/in-service) from the Mechanical wing, who have not uploaded their APRs for the last 5 years, their Work & Conduct and Integrity Certificates on JKPWDOMS and posting details on the VC portal, are once again advised to upload these documents within ten (10) days time so as to enable the Department to consider their cases for promotion/regularization:-

If any of these officers fails to upload the required documents despite this notice, it shall be personal responsibility of the officer for not being considered for such regularization.
